We welcomed over 100 clients and their guests to our annual Christmas Party on Friday 14th December.


We were delighted that Father Christmas, with his Chief Elf Mary, were able to join us this year to dispense Christmas cheer and to join in with the fun and games.

Many thanks to Heads Up for such an enjoyable social event.


Thank You!

to us of £250. We are very pleased to have been nominated to receive this contribution. Thank you to all concerned.


