Headway Black Country is working with Base 25 to pilot a new service for Young Adults affected by acquired brain injury.

WHO?

It is for 18-30 year olds who have sustained an acquired brain injury and who live in the Black Country.

WHAT?

The pilot will be for 6 months initially. We hope it will become a long-term group.

In the first six months there will be:

- ▶ A "drop-in" on the first Tuesday of each month where you can meet others and enjoy refreshments in a relaxed, social environment.
- ▶ Additional, optional activities which will be chosen by the group.

We are not able to provide one to one support but you can bring a personal assistant with you.

WHEN?

Our first event is on Tuesday 1st October 2019 from 6pm until 8 pm.

IS THERE A COST?

There is no charge for the session on 1st October. There will be a cost for attending each monthly drop in session after 1st October, costs are to be confirmed.

If you are supported by Adult Social Care we will ask them to fund your attendance.

Optional activities that happen between the monthly drop ins - you may be asked to pay towards these.

This will vary depending on the activity.
